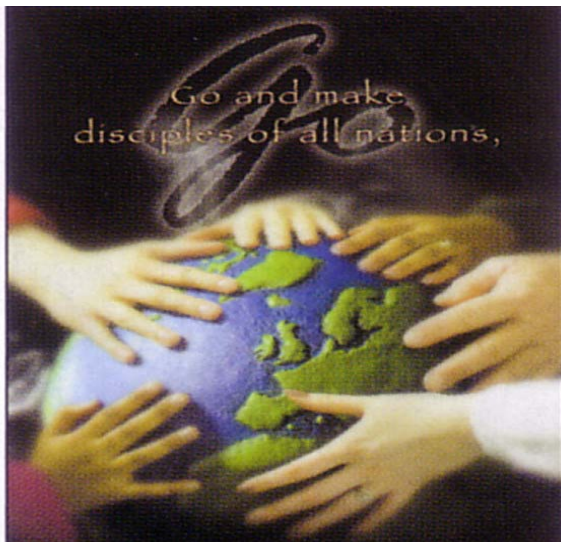

Taiwan Mission Foundation, Inc. (TMF) is a not-for-profit corporation established to bring the gospel of Jesus Christ to Taiwan. TMF was incorporated in New York on April 24, 2007, and is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization.

Although the gospel was originally brought to Taiwan by missionaries almost 150 years ago, only 3% of the population in Taiwan today is Christian. TMF seeks to work together with local churches throughout the U.S. to support missions work in Taiwan, with the goal of seeing its percentage of Christians increase to 10% in the next ten years.



TMF seeks to carry out Jesus' teaching of the Great Commission by combining the preaching of the gospel with tangible acts of love and charity. TMF supports missions efforts by utilizing a variety of charitable outreach programs, including:

- ♦ Teaching English to children in Taiwan
- ♦ Ministries to low-income workers, the elderly, and broken families in isolated villages
- ♦ Prison outreach
- ♦ Medical missions

- ♦ Providing support and encouragement to patients with cancer and other terminal illnesses
- ♦ Campus ministries to Taiwanese students studying in the United States

How you can get involved:

1. **Pray:** TMF encourages local churches and fellowships to form prayer teams to support missions teams and pray for missions outreach in Taiwan.
2. **Send.** Individuals who support missionaries through encouragement, logistical support, and financial giving are a critical part of the missions effort. The Great Commission cannot be carried out without a strong backbone of senders. TMF's goal is to raise \$10 million to support Taiwan missions efforts. As of June 2007, TMF has received pledges of up to \$720,000. Your support will help TMF reach its financial goals and enhance its efforts to bring the gospel to Taiwan. All donations are tax-deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law.
3. **Go.** TMF encourages everyone who loves Jesus Christ and has a heart for the people of Taiwan to participate in short- and long-term missions work. Whether you are young or old, Taiwanese or Chinese American or any other race or ethnicity, TMF encourages you to utilize your talents to help share the gospel with those in Taiwan. Short-term missions projects are usually one to three week trips to one or more local communities in Taiwan. In addition to providing organizational and logistical support for missions teams, TMF will financially support the teams by providing \$1,000 in financial support to the organizer of a 10-member team. Through "\$1,000 one team," TMF hopes to encourage

many teams to go and serve the numerous local communities throughout Taiwan.

4. **Mobilize.** TMF is seeking volunteers throughout the United States to help mobilize individuals in local communities to participate in missions teams, and to organize community support for its missions efforts to Taiwan.
