Policy for supporting Cancer Patients Outreach Programs:

Taiwan Mission Foundation (TMF) will offer one or more of the following types of support to any church or charitable organization that demonstrates an interest and commitment to conducting a cancer patient outreach program to the Taiwanese community and has signed up at least five (5) cancer patients to participate in the program:

1. Provide an educational workshop for the church/organization members before the program begins, including understanding cancer patient needs, and how to structure appropriate physical and spiritual support to meet those needs.
2. Provide financial and/or in kind support to develop the program, which may include but not be limited to exercise equipment (e.g. a ping-pong table), spiritual support materials, etc. C/organizations receiving such financial and/or in kind support must agree in writing to use such support specifically of their cancer patient out reach program
3. Provide coordination between and among various churches and organizations dealing with the care of cancer patients.
